<input type="checkbox"/> Maple, striped (shrub, small tree)	Acer pensylvanicum
<input type="checkbox"/> Dogwood (shrub, small tree)	Cornus spp.

#### Alternate leaves and buds

<input type="checkbox"/> Aspen, trembling	Populus grandidentata
<input type="checkbox"/> Birch, white	Betula sp.
<input type="checkbox"/> Beech, american	Fagus grandifolia
<input type="checkbox"/> Oak, red	"Quercus, rubra"
<input type="checkbox"/> Sumac (shrub, small tree)	Rhus. spp.
